## **Andrographis Complex**

Andrographis Complex is a unique combination of Andrographis leaf, *Echinacea angustifolia* root and Holy Basil (leaf and leaf essential oil).\*

Clinical trials suggest that to be effective Andrographis products should contain substantial levels of the important plant constituents: andrographolides.1\*

Holy Basil is considered to be sacred by Hindus. It is commonly planted next to temples,<sup>2</sup> and the water the herb is dipped in is used as sacred water in many temples in India.<sup>3</sup> Good quality Holy Basil leaf contains not less than 0.5% essential oil.<sup>4\*</sup>

In the late 19th-Century natural clinicians in the United States noted of Echinacea root that "when chewed the root, if of good quality, imparts a persistent tingling sensation". We now know that this tingling sensation is caused by the presence of the plant constituents called alkylamides (pronounced al-kyl-a-mydes).\*

## How Andrographis Complex Keeps You Healthy Supports healthy immune function

Native Americans used *Echinacea angustifolia* root to support the immune system.<sup>6</sup> We now know that constituents in Echinacea root known as alkylamides are very important for this activity. They may do this because they are able to interact with certain immune receptors<sup>7-9</sup> ("switching on" the tissues resulting in a healthy immune response).<sup>\*</sup>

Andrographis and Holy Basil also support healthy immune function.<sup>1,10\*</sup>

## Supports healthy respiratory system function

Andrographis extracts containing a known amount of andrographolides support the healthy functioning of the upper respiratory tract.¹ This includes the throat, sinuses and the lungs. Andrographis may do this by supporting a healthy immune response,¹¹ and helping to maintain normal body temperature that is within a normal range.¹²\*

Echinacea and Holy Basil also support healthy respiratory system function.<sup>13,14</sup> Holy Basil may do this by supporting a healthy immune response, particularly by enhancing the normal function of polymorphonuclear cells.<sup>10</sup> Polymorphonuclear cells are a type of phagocytic cell. Phagocytosis is a process involving certain white blood cells that engulf and digest foreign particles or cells that invade the body. It is possible that good quality Echinacea root works in a similar way.<sup>15,16\*</sup>

## Promotes healthy liver function
