Large intestine: helps with waste removal

Natural clinicians have long understood the connection between a healthy, vital body and normal, healthy elimination.¹ The body has several systems that deal with elimination, including the large intestine of the gastrointestinal tract. The main function of the large intestine (or colon) is the absorption of water, which is the most important step in the making of feces (waste). The amount of time that food spends in the large intestine varies from 8 to 15 hours. If the passage is too slow, and too much water is absorbed, dehydration of the feces may cause occasional constipation. Peristalsis is the movement produced by the smooth muscle that pushes the contents (food and the resulting waste material) along the gastrointestinal tract.² A healthy intestine has a healthy tone in its tissue layers, including the smooth muscle layers, and it has healthy reflex responses.³*

The large intestine is the natural habitat for a large and diverse population of microorganisms (called 'flora'), mainly bacteria. In normal healthy circumstances the relationship is mutually beneficial for both partners: bacteria and host (you!). For example, the intestinal flora helps release absorbable nutrients and substances that can be used for energy.⁴ The normal passage of feces through the large intestine is an important factor in helping to maintain a healthy population of intestinal flora. Healthy intestinal flora contributes to a healthy intestine and overall good health.^{5*}

The liver makes bile which is stored in the gallbladder and is released when needed into the duodenum and down the intestinal tract. Bile has a number of functions including assisting in fat digestion and absorption, and excretion of several important waste products from the blood.³ Bile also stimulates peristalsis in the large intestine.^{6*}

Cascara and Yellow Dock have been used traditionally for temporary relief of occasional, mild constipation.7,9*

Stimulates bile production and flow, and provides digestive support

Dandelion Root is traditionally used to assist the normal production of bile in the liver.⁷ A placebo-controlled trial with healthy volunteers found that Cascara stimulated the normal emptying of the gallbladder.¹¹ This has the dual effect of assisting with the digestion of fat and improving elimination by encouraging healthy bowel function.*
